OUR GUIDING PRINCIPLES: We are rooted in Christ. We know all people are of great value. We serve our neighbors in all their needs. We nurture faith among all the generations.

Our Lenten season is something of an echo of the 40 days of Jesus going into the wild. Early in his public ministry he entered the dangerous, threatening and deceptive desert. At that place he is the embodiment of the Good News – "this is my Beloved" – on 'the way of the cross.' In this journey of Jesus and us, temptations and affirmations are the hallmarks of what it means to be 'wrestling in the wilderness.'



Have you seen? In the rooms of our church are newly created Centerpieces – on each fellowship table and near our communion table – they portray the images of 'bringing the wilderness in' (Thanks to the artistry of Pam). In these images and our language we disclose how the wild-ness of our experiences in this world are the very location we might take seriously our call to follow. Ultimately, therein is an invitation to pay deeper attention to our present scandals and the divine claim on us there – You are mine; I am with you to make all things new.

So I wonder about your personal wilderness...and also our wilderness as a community of faith. We are invited to become more attentive. Where are you threatened and deceived, child of God? And where do we struggle to be a faithful congregation? What are we learning from God through the various dangers and ditches? And what are the new shapes of our trust in God's guidance...where faith and life is 'born even in barrenness', nurtured, challenged, and resurrected by the unwavering love and mercy in Jesus?

We are experiencing exciting developments at Shepherd of the Mountains:

Love Where You Live – on Monday evenings (see page 4)
Please come when you can; We are at the beginning stages;
An intentional effort of letting God get through to us;
Not merely intellectual work, but hearing God in the shaping of our hearts;
The invitation of Jesus is to pay attention to our quiet inner work too;
To love our neighbor as ourselves – akin with loving God with heart, strength, soul, mind

Lenten Meals – what are an incredibly gracious event for our faith community;

AND FOR THE WIDER COMMUNITY – great soups and fixins provided; 5:30 to 7:00pm

Our challenge is TO INVITE and ACCOMPANY our neighbors;

Where conversations flow freely; a poem and brief discussion is added;

We are paying attention to 'the wild' in our daily lives.

Our Guiding Principles (above) are channeling our community toward mission, though the wild is constant with danger and lies and doubling down. Christ promises to reshape us by giving us what we need to be the children of God. In all our wilderness experiences...is the presence of God.
