Reflections from Your Pastor: Saying YES in Advent



The Season of Advent is Unfolding

What a celebration!...at the final Sunday of the church year—*Christ the King*—with meaningful worship then enjoying the many gifts of our community in a delightful, delicious Thanksgiving meal. I feel grateful for our thoughtful and generous sisters and brothers sharing these adventures of faith and life together. Then, by the next Sunday, we open our lives to the next church year emerging as *Advent*—faith in the shape of “hope being born into a weary world.”

Anything New this Advent?

Our life of discipleship includes the ongoing invitation to hear God saying, “*behold everything is new.*” So, responding with “Yes” is not unknown to followers of Jesus, like us. But perhaps the freshness of this year’s Advent series—*The Power of Yes*—has more to do with repetition. Like every Advent season before: we hear the stories again, year after year. The biblical stories don’t change. Actually, times have changed, and we have changed; and we will change.

Maybe we’ve experienced even more changes this year—with valleys ‘as deep as ever,’ and with mountains to climb ‘as high as ever.’ Thus could our ears be attuned to God in different ways these days? Might we see differently how God is active in our world, in our lives?—where God’s incarnate love enters this fragile, broken world as we haven’t experienced before? Sounds like we are opening ourselves to the way of God with us called: transformation.

The Power of saying Yes (an invitation, by Shawna Berg, Director of Children, Youth, and Family Ministry at St. Andrew Lutheran Church in Eden Prairie, MN)

The series—*The Power of Yes*—reframes Advent not just a countdown to Christmas, but also as an invitation for us to yes to what God is calling us to do in our lives, even if that means there is something we may have to say no to. It is about being intentional. It is about helping others see what the yes moments are in their own lives, that have helped shape their own faith journeys.

Where do you see the power of yes showing up in your own life?

I see the power of yes showing up when I say yes to community, when isolation would be easier.
I see the power of yes showing up when I say yes to healing and forgiveness, even when it is hard.
I see the power of yes showing up when I say yes I see the power of yes showing up when I say yes to generosity, even when I worry about having enough. I see the power of yes showing up when I say yes to joy, even when I want to be a cynic. Choosing my yes, and conversely my no, carefully, means that I am living with intention and purpose.

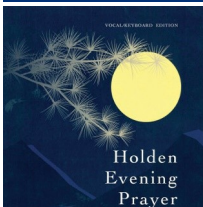

The Power of Yes

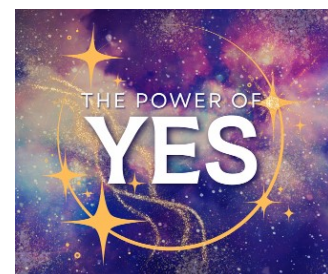

A Message About Reverends Wilson & Ezekiel



Asante Sana! Thank you, Northwest Intermountain Synod, for the wonderful welcome you extended to our companions from the Ulanga Kilombero Diocese of the Evangelical Lutheran Church in Tanzania. Our guests were impressed by the size of our synod, the warm hospitality they received, and the vast array of ministries of our NWIM Synod people. I hope you had a chance to meet these remarkable pastors and engage in our relationship with the people of our companion synod. They ask that I pass along their deep appreciation for the time they were with us!

Unfortunately, Ezekiel and Wilson had a rough trip home. Due to the civil unrest in Tanzania after their presidential election on October 28, flights into the country were cancelled for about a week. It took our guests 9 days to get home – spending 6 nights in Nairobi, thankfully at a Christian retreat center. As soon as it was safe to travel, they were able to make it home to the loving arms of their families!

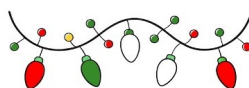

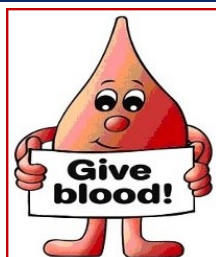
